

LITTLE FOX RACE REGULATIONS

1. Organiser

Alpski smučarski klub Branik Maribor is organizing the international Little Fox Race for children. The international event is a competition with a giant slalom and a team event race.

2. Categories

The Little Fox Race is reserved exclusively for the following categories:

- U8 (Born between 2009 - 2010)
- U10 (Born between 2007 - 2008)
- U12 (Born between 2005 - 2006)
- U14 (Born between 2003 - 2004)
- U16 (Born between 2001 - 2002)

The U8 category cannot participate at the team event.

3. Registration

Registration must be submitted by **January 24, 2017** in writing, via e-mail to: littlefox@ask-branik.si. Registration for the giant slalom is valid upon payment of the registration fee, which is **25€** per athlete. The application fee is non-refundable. Registrations by phone are not possible.

The first 500 applicants will receive a generous goody bag.

Registration form must contain the following data: the name, registered office address, nationality, telephone, and most importantly, an **e-mail address**. The information must be identical for each race at which the club participates. All participants must specify their full name, sex and year of birth, dividing males and females.

By registering for the competition the competitor (or in his name a coach or parent) gives permission to the organiser to publicly display provided personal information and the competitors results, photo or video images obtained during his participation in the competition as well as posting the competitors photo or video on the official competition website, in public announcements etc. with the purpose of informing the general public of the event as well as presenting the event in commercial manners. The organiser has the right to collect, analyse and save the competitors personal information as well as the information and photo and video material the organiser obtained for which he does not need additional specific permission from the competitor or parent/coach. Furthermore, the organiser is not obligated to financially compensate the competitor in any manner. The organiser obliges to protect the personal competitor information obtained in accordance with the Law pertaining to the protection of personal information and will ensure the competitors all rights specified under this law are enforced (the right to view the information obtained, the right that ensures obtained personal information is not without their consent passed onto third party, or that the information would be used for other non-related purposes, that upon competitor request the organiser will stop using the personal information for commercial purposes).

4. Registration for the side-event

It is preferred that the request for participation in the »POK« race or team event is given at the moment of race registration. The closing date to register for this side-event competition is after the **coaches' meeting on Friday evening, January 27, 2017**. The goal of the Organizing Committee, that every ski-club can participate with at minimum one team per side-event. The fee for the team event is 30€ per team (for 2nd team from the same club the entry fee is 20€ and for 3rd team is 10€). There is no fee for the participation at the »POK« night race. Incorrect information on the entries will lead to disqualification of the participant or team in question.

5. Ski pass

All the athletes, their parents and / or chaperones who will book their accommodation with the Official Accommodation Partner, Martura d.o.o., will also be able to buy ski passes on reduced price.

If the club is not located in one of the Official Accommodation Partner accommodations, only full price tickets are available.

6. Giant Slalom: Allotment into groups and starting order

The starting order for the various categories will be decided through a computer lottery system. First two athletes of each category are included to the first group, all the rest are included to the second group. The athletes with the best results in each category should be put on the first two places of the application form.

7. Team Event: giant slalom relay race between teams

On Sunday, January 29, 2017 the team event will take place. This event is open to all registered participants of the giant slalom, born between 2001 and 2008. The team must be comprised of

one competitor from each category: U10, U12, U14, U16 + trainer. If there the club does not have competitors in all categories, the missing spot can be filled with a competitor from lower category. Males and females will compete together. The club must inform the organiser the names of the participants and their starting-order no later than Friday, January 27, 2017, after the coaches' meeting.

Participants may only compete for the club in which they are members. It is not permitted to exchange athletes, even if one ski-club has numerous teams entered, there can be no exchange of athletes between teams belonging to the same ski club. If a team starts with a non-member participant, it will be disqualified. The results are valid only if all participants have completed the course following the regulations and in numerical order.

The race is based on a tournament scheme. A random draw will assign teams to the blue or red track. The fastest team of two rival teams will qualify for the next round and all the way to the final. Detailed regulations will be given to all competitors at the competition itself.

8. »Pok« Night Race: parallel relay race between teams

On Saturday, January 28, 2017, a fun and humorous race with a "Pok" will be organized. Where children, otherwise athletes turn into fans and the racing polygon is occupied by coaches, parents and mascots. The mascot will be the team captain and will be connected to a predetermined number of people. The whole team will compete in the parallel relay race with a "Pok" on a fun track. The contest will be based on a tournament scheme. A random draw will assign teams to the blue or red track. The fastest team of two rival teams will quality to the next round and all the way to the finals.

9. Responsibility

Even races for children and young people can lead to injuries. The organizers assume no liability for accidents which occur before, during or after races. Participation is entirely at the risk of the athletes, their parents and / or chaperones.

Use of a helmet during races is mandatory for all participants!

10. Awards

The giant slalom will be awarded from 1st to 3rd place. The winning team of the team event will get an all-inclusive 5-day cruise for 10 people on the Adriatic Sea. There are symbolic awards for the winners of the »Pok« race.

11. Bibs bingo

For the bibs bingo, the starting number on the race bib of the individual participants will be used and this must be brought to the draw by the athletes. The prize will be awarded to the attending participant whose bib number is drawn. If the winning participant is not present at the time of the draw or does not have the bib, a new winning number will be drawn. The race bibs can be kept as souvenirs.

12. Changes in programme

The Organizing Committee reserves the right, if necessary, to alter the programme.
